## **Baroness Helena Kennedy QC, Chair, Arts & Business**

---

Annual reports are historical documents by their very nature and should reflect what is happening in the wider world. No organisation operates within a vacuum and these are going to be very difficult times.

As our fiscal year ended in late March 2008, Arts & Business faced the challenge of reconfiguring its work within new budget constraints placed upon us by the Arts Council. This meant a reassessment of our operation but at Arts & Business necessity always mothers creativity and, after a strategic review of our activities, we saw both business and arts companies developing stronger and more effective partnerships. In fact, our work found new expression.

However, despite the high energy and glow of success in Arts & Business, we are alert to the changed environment. Very few commentators would have forecast the depth of the financial crisis and economic recession that is now gripping world markets. We are seeing leading sponsors taken over or vanish before our eyes. Lehman Brothers had become an important UK sponsor in recent years and Bank of Scotland alone had given unrivalled support to the arts in Scotland, notably the Edinburgh International Festival, for over 50 years. As I write, very little is known as to the extent or timeframe of the turbulence that we are undergoing. But what we do know is that we must not become prophets of our own doom.

Arts & Business is clear as to our role going forward. We must support and be seen to support the arts and businesses which are facing the most challenging environment in living memory. The arts have always acted not only as a commentator on society, but also as a beacon to lighten and enlighten us in difficult and dark times. That light has never been extinguished and the remarkable achievements of business in support of the arts will continue.

## Colin Tweedy, Chief Executive, Arts & Business

---

The year 2007/08 can be seen as a turning point for Arts & Business. We completed our strategic review and prepared the ground for the restructuring of our English offices in the new financial year.

After 24 years our investment programmes in England, matching public money with private, were wound down at the end of March 2008, due to new directions of the Arts Council England. In its last year it was good to see that these investment programmes helped lever £8.8 million of new money to the arts in the UK. However, I am pleased that investment programmes will continue in other parts of the UK.

At the beginning of January we were able to announce a record figure of nearly £600 million of private funds supporting the arts during the previous year. Arts & Business can never claim to be responsible for raising such a figure alone. But when we look back to our foundation in 1976 and note that the total figure then was merely £600,000, one can take pride in the transformation of our marketplace in the subsequent 32 years.

It can be seen from our activities and achievements (highlighted in this review) that 2007/08 was a busy and successful year. It provided strong foundations from which to roll out new activities in the years to come. Arts & Business has continually evolved throughout the years; new initiatives are needed for changing times. The challenge of the global recession is affecting everyone and no one, as yet, knows what damage will be done to every sector of the economy and society.

The arts and business communities are fundamental to our country's future. Arts & Business must be there, ready and able, to support both sectors in developing dynamic and creative partnerships. The men and women who work in Arts & Business deserve my gratitude for the maturity they have shown in difficult times. We have said goodbye to colleagues in our restructuring, to whom we also owe a debt of gratitude. Any organisation is merely as good as the people who work in it.

Arts & Business strives to be a catalyst for both the private and cultural sectors in transforming the way they work together. Without the support of both these communities, we could not fulfil our mission. Our thanks to all our partners, in business, the arts and the public sector UK wide, is heartfelt.

### Creating Impact by Sharing Learning

**Collaborations between business and the arts are more inventive and ambitious than ever before. We know this because over our 32-year history, Arts & Business has built up the intellectual property of our marketplace.**

We work to stimulate even greater quality in these partnerships. We do this by sharing and advocating our experience and innovative thinking through surveys, case studies, evaluation methodologies and market insights.

Our annual flagship Private Investment in Culture Survey (the only report survey analysing private sector investment in the arts) identifies the total figure for private investment in the arts as close to £600 million. This is the highest it has ever been.

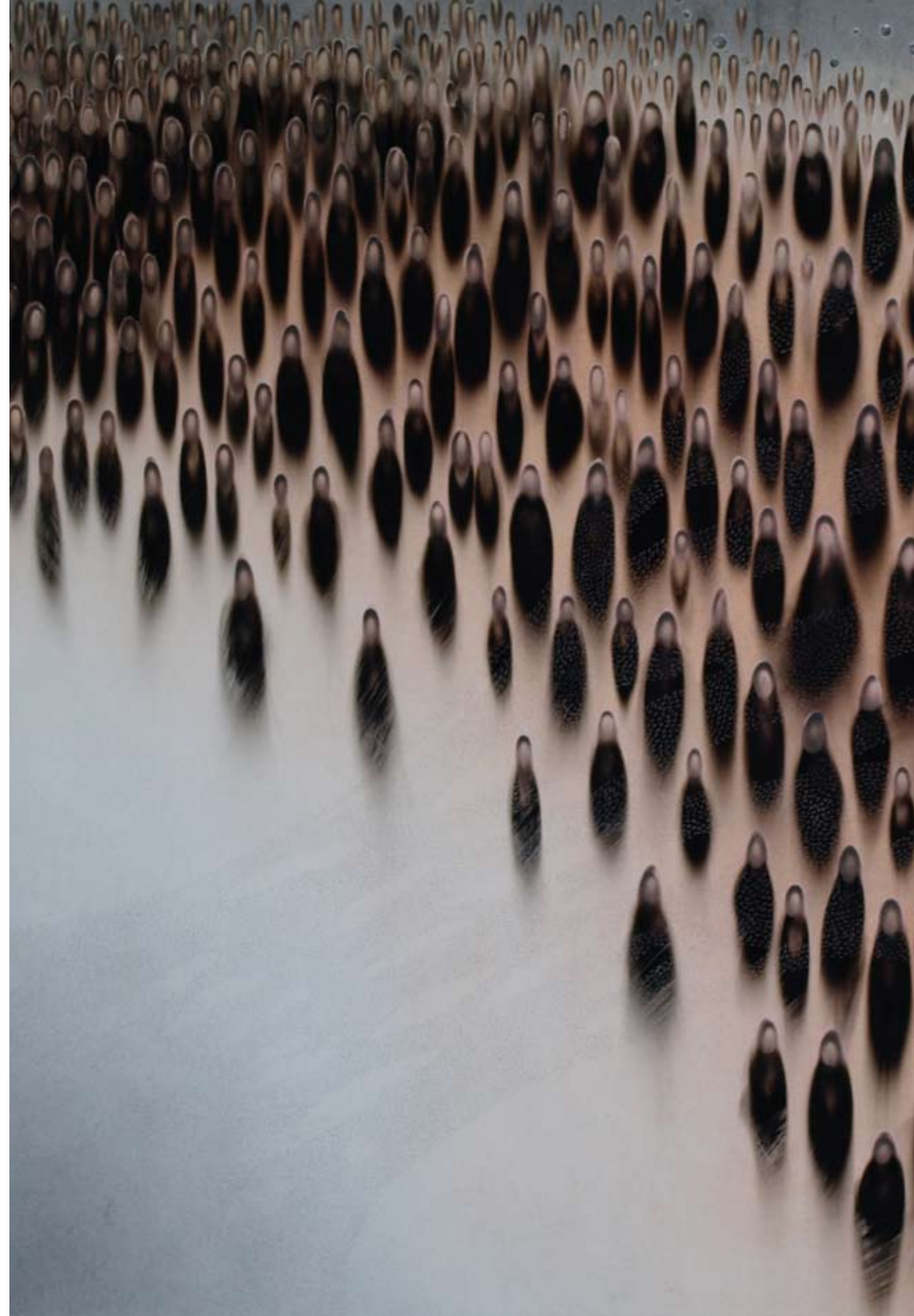
These findings alone reached over 800,000 interested parties. But we have to tell the stories behind these figures. It is crucial that we continue to highlight the contribution of the private sector the funding ecology of the arts. ## Inspiring Change through People

**It is not enough to express Arts & Business' telling contribution and value solely through numbers. They do, however, give a clear sense of how many professionals we reach in commerce and culture through our progressive network.**

- 518 business members encompass the majority of corporate sponsors of the arts and provide the business backbone for the arts throughout the UK.
- Arts & Business' Development Forum (arts) membership has increased by 5% to over 1,100 participants in 2007/ 08 as more in the arts seek out the best ways to work with the private sector.
- We work hard to instil new thinking and ideas within the arts and participants in Arts & Business' advanced sponsorship and individual giving seminars have risen 25% to just under 2,000.
- More and more the commercial world is looking to the arts for creative solutions and we were the catalyst for 1,650 business employees to engage in creative development projects last year.
- Arts & Business continues to create opportunities for business individuals to share their time and their expertise to benefit over 160 arts organisations and their boards.
- To sustain the passion and imagination of the sector, Arts & Business' events programme shares specialist insights. Our national awards showcase the best partnerships from across the UK. Over 4,000 guests came to an Arts & Business' event to find ways of putting cultural and commercial partnerships at the heart of their work in 2007/08.





## Developing Vibrant and Diverse Communities

### Arts & Business considers the wider perspective of social inclusion in the UK as a priority concern.

BME-led and disability arts organisations benefit significantly from Arts & Business' arts capacity building work; 9% of investments went to projects embracing diversity.

As a founding member of the GAIN (Governance, Access, Inclusion and Networking) programme in partnership with Arts Council England, Museums Libraries and Archives, Sporting Equals and the Greater London Authority, Arts & Business continues to support the diversity of arts organisations at board level. We reach out to increase the awareness of, and commitment to, diversity issues within the arts.

Arts & Business brokered a £60,000 sponsorship between Wates and the Koestler Trust for support of their Arts By Offenders programme working with prisons across the country.

## Influencing Change through Global Partnerships

---

**Our influence is global. We exchange ideas across over 35 countries. This keeps our thinking fresh. It also helps maintain the UK's profile for excellence in the arts. Across the globe, we hear how the UK is the envy of the world when it comes to the arts funding ecology. Arts & Business wants to ensure the UK continues to lead the way.**

We make sure that the influences from abroad benefit the UK. We hosted a conference on developing international business/arts partnerships with representatives from 22 countries and delivered a week-long series of training programmes and activities in Beijing.

Co-funding was used as an advocacy tool by Arts & Business to encourage new arts-business relationships for Liverpool European Capital of Culture in 2008.

Arts & Business has been working with London 2012 to support their plans for the Cultural Olympiad.





## Visual – Bringing Contemporary Art to Business

---

**Visual is a unique and flexible service from Arts & Business bringing high-quality contemporary art to businesses and business people. Having piloted Visual in the Midlands, the new service was launched at Baskerville House, Birmingham in 2008. We have already delivered exceptional work for clients such as Ernst & Young, Aston Business School, Birmingham Chamber of Commerce, City Inn and Crosby Lend Lease.**

We only work with artists who have been selected by panels of experts. This ensures that clients acquire, commission or borrow work from artists who are both respected and provide good value for money.

Visual was launched with 65 professional artists. By 2009, we will expand this to over 150 to meet the demand from the North West, the East Midlands, the South East and the South West.

Our clients use Visual to build their brand, inspire their people, deliver their community investment agenda and create dynamic interiors in which to do business.

Culture House is a membership network for individuals who want to deepen their understanding and involvement in cultural philanthropy. It provides a unique doorway into the heart of the cultural world. Culture House members are conducted through the exciting journey of philanthropy, with opportunities to engage directly with many of the UK’s most outstanding artists and performers and key figures from across the arts, media, business and political worlds.

We work with our members on a range of philanthropic activities. Already this year, Culture House has supported the work of the Akram Khan Company and Juliette Binoche in the groundbreaking production *In-i*; developed the Culture House Student Award 2008 in collaboration with Chelsea College of Arts & Design and commissioned the experimental ‘Walking in the City’ piece from former scratch orchestra artist Michael Parsons.



## Financial Highlights

---

### The results of the Arts & Business Group in the year to 31 March 2008 include the operating activities of all Arts & Business's regional offices together with the results of its trading subsidiary, Arts & Business Services Limited ("Services").

On 1 April 2007, The Prince's Foundation for Children and the Arts (or "Arts & Kids"), formerly a part of the Arts & Business Group, became an independent organisation.

#### Services

Arts & Business's trading company broke even in 2007/08, as it did in the preceding year. Its turnover fell marginally to £1,122k, but the prior year's results included income of £122k derived from Arts & Kids sponsorships so the 2007/08 figure represents a real increase of approximately £120k. There was a fall in the income derived from Business Membership which was partially offset by an increase in income from Business Consultancy. There was an increase of approximately £100k in earned income thanks to a number of commercial projects undertaken in the regions, e.g. Visual. Services made a distribution under Gift Aid to the parent charity of £14k (2007: £6k).

#### Group

The Group's incoming resources (i.e. its income) decreased by £360k to £8,927k. The total resources expended fell by £1,013k to £8,425k, and the charitable expenditure fell by 14% to £7,624k - largely as a result of the cut-back in Arts & Business's investment programmes although there was an increase in the expenditure on the business-facing activities. The total costs of generating funds rose by 38% to £801k.

The Group result for the year was a surplus of £502k compared to a deficit of £157k in the preceding year. The 2006/07 figure included net expenditure related to Arts & Kids of £194k.

#### Arts Council England

In January 2008, Arts Council England announced that its grant to Arts & Business for the three years commencing 2008/09 would be cut by one-third to £4m per year. As a result, some projects were deferred or cancelled in order to reduce expenditure whilst Arts & Business restructured itself. The 2007/08 accounts included a provision of £217k for this purpose and it was completed in the summer of 2008.

#### Balance Sheet

The Group's free reserves decreased by £882k to £542k and at the year-end the total reserves amounted to £2,119k.

#### Financial information

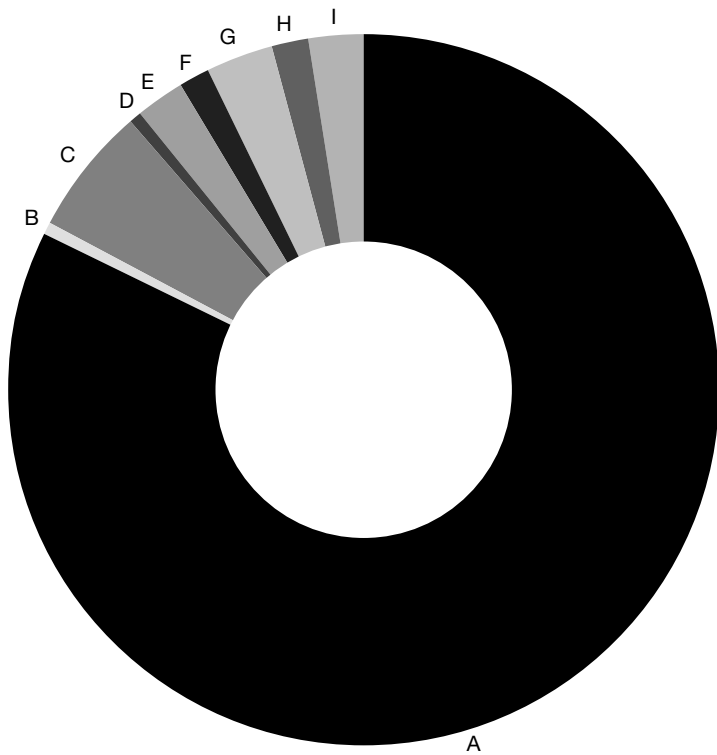
The above information has been extracted from the full Trustees' Report & Financial Statements of the Arts & Business group which have been audited by Horwath Clark Whitehill LLP who gave an unqualified audit report on 30 September 2008. The auditors have confirmed to the trustees that the summarised Financial Statements are consistent with the full Financial Statements for the year ended 31 March 2008. The Trustees' Report and the Financial Statements were approved by the trustees and signed on their behalf on 10 July 2008. They will be submitted to the Charity Commission on 31 December 2008.

These summarised Financial Statements may not contain sufficient information to gain a complete understanding of the financial affairs of the charity. 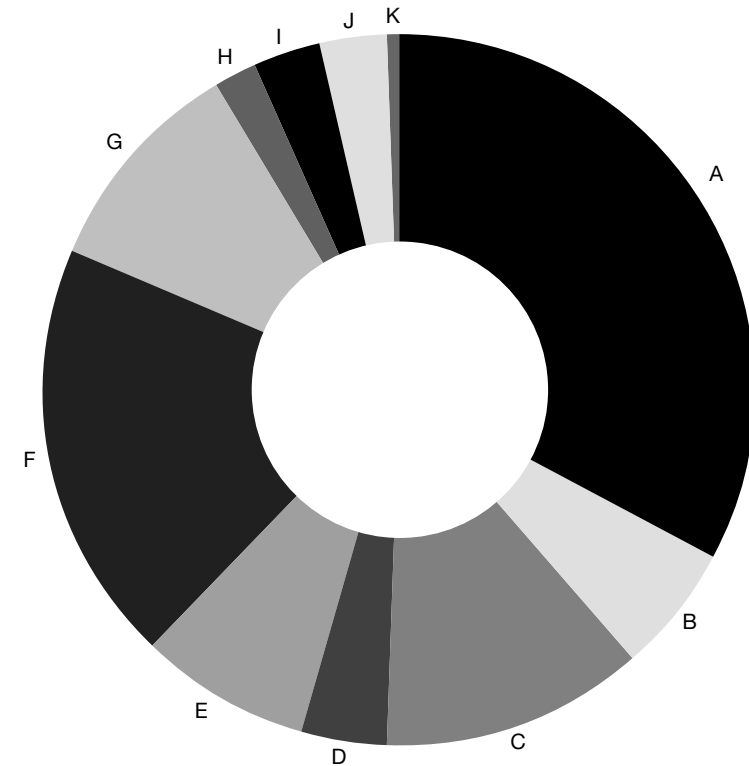
